



OUR LADY OF LOURDES is your parish and this is who we are and what's happening!

DID YOU KNOW . . .

- ❖ We have 1,381 registered families, which consists of 3,811 members; this includes the 298 non-Catholic members. Of the total parish, 1041 families (74%) have recommitted themselves to the parish and to a stewardship way of life by returning their 2011 Stewardship Intention Card.
- ❖ Last fiscal year, we celebrated 80 baptisms, 72 first communions, 55 confirmations, 10 marriages, 31 funerals and welcomed 8 new members into the church through RCIA.
- ❖ The median age of all parishioners is 33; the age breakdown is as follows:

- ❖ Of the 2,396 parishioners 25 years of age or older -- 70% are married
8% are widowed
8% are separated or divorced
14% are single
- ❖ 54% of our members are female, and 46% are male.
- ❖ Of our parishioners, 69 are either homebound or in a nursing home.
- ❖ 41% of parishioners have been in the parish more than 10 years and 17% have been in the parish less than 3 years. A total of 81 families or 6% have joined the parish in the last fiscal year – welcome to Lourdes!
- ❖ Parish households reside in 36 different zip codes in KY plus in four other states – FL, IN, IL, GA.
- ❖ 757 (55%) of parish households have children and 162 of them are single parent households.

- ❖ The parish now has 122 active ministries. 52% of all parishioners are represented in at least one ministry. 1,992 parishioners fill 5,652 ministry opportunities which is an average of 2.8 ministries per person. Of the 1,992 active parishioners, 138 of these wonderful stewards are non-Catholic so a special 'Thank You' to each of you! These gifts of time and talent are essential to the parish mission. This does NOT include the unrecorded number of parishioners that are involved in the many school, sports, and special events throughout the year. A big THANK YOU to all our active parishioners!
- ❖ The most common occupation is Homemaker held by 307 parish moms, this is followed by our Retired force of 254 parishioners.
- ❖ This year there are 450 students (which includes 43 tuition children & 290 school families) in our parish school – Pre-K thru 8th grade). In addition to our parish school, there are approximately 117 students in our Evening Religious Education program; ERE students come from more than 12 different parishes.
- ❖ The 2011-12 annual cost to educate a child in our parish school is approximately \$5,000 per student. This cost has been maintained thanks to the active number of parishioners involved in supporting this ministry.
