K- traveled safely in space, rolled a ball, jumped over a long rope, moved in the 6 directions, moved creatively to music, and explored different ways of manipulating a hula hoop

8B- practiced volleyball, and floor hockey. They learned how to read food labels, worked with a group to create and then present a rhythmic routine with equipment, and participated in a variety of problem-solving/cooperative activities.
