Committee introductions were made for the five new PC members.

Minutes of the July Parish Council meeting were approved.

## **Committee Reports**

### **Worship (Kathy P)**

Committee is still looking for a Hospitality coordinator. Robert Parks described the job duties. Job is more challenging when we have special Masses such as on holy days, holidays, celebration of sacraments, etc.

### **Outreach (Christine K)**

Committee is still looking for a Chair. Budget was approved. They are working on the schedule for the new fiscal year's Outreach collections.

Hand-in-Hand "Shred-It" drive thru event will be on Saturday, October 18 at 9am.

### **School Advisory Committee (Liz M)**

Four new members were welcomed at first meeting of the new school year.

In November the school will have the Archdiocesan accreditation visit. These accreditation visits occur every three years. The visit involves interviews with parents, parishioners, etc.

### **Pastor's Report**

Fr David explained the various ways the parish communicates with parishioners by using several media sources.

Parking lot: Father reported the insurance company for the Archdiocese advised that parishioners and neighbors should not be allowed to park overnight on the parish grounds due to liability issues.

Father found that Catholic bibles were not being used in all school classrooms. He explained the issue to the teachers as they were setting up classrooms this August. Replacement bibles will be purchased.

Father reminded us that sponsors for sacraments, such as Confirmation, must be living in accord with the teachings of the Catholic Church. This is required by Canon Law.

Parish Council minutes, once they have been approved by Parish Council, will now be posted on the parish website by Emilia Agrinoni-Malavé, Communications.

A signed approval from the Archbishop is needed before the bank will provide the \$3million dollars to the parish and a ground-breaking celebration can be held.

Father said the \$40,000 of the School Legacy Fund that had been planned to be transferred to the Capital Campaign was not transferred out of the Fund.

Religious Education - Father is reviewing the books being used.

### **Adult Faith Formation (Jim L)**

OCIA - Currently there are three Catechumens and five Candidates. This is subject to change.  
Family Catechesis- about twenty-five children are currently enrolled.
